

A prison-based thriller that is perfect for fans of the TV show *Prison Break*.

Divorced and unemployed, Stéphane is leading a sad and solitary life when he suddenly receives an unexpected phone call from Bolivia and is told that his long-estranged son, Max, has died in San Pedro Prison, a unique detention facility that is run by the prisoners themselves.

Stéphane decides to uncover the mysterious circumstances of his son's death and leaves for Bolivia. Upon arriving, he succeeds in getting himself incarcerated in San Pedro Prison to carry out his investigation at the risk of his own life...

Inside this prison, a veritable hell on earth, Stéphane is prepared to do whatever it takes to learn the truth, in the hope that doing so will bring about his own redemption.

Story by Jean-Blaise Dijan, a seasoned writer who collaborated on the series The Baker Street Four and Le Grand Mort with Régis Loisel.



Jean-Blaise Mitildjian, known as Djian, is a comic book writer. After learning the conventions of comics from Régis Loisel, they subsequently collaborated on the sagas Les Belles histoires d'Onc's Renaud (Delcourt) and Le Grand Mort (Vents d'Ouest). His new comic book, Au Nom du fils, was co-written with his daughter Pauline Mitildjian.

After studying advertising, Sébastien Corbet turned to music. At the same time, he painted and exhibited for ten years, before returning to his first passion: comics. He met the scriptwriter Djian, with whom he signed his first children's comic book in 2008, Les p'tits Philous, since then they were working together on various projects.

Taking advantage of this return to nature to recharge her batteries, she sets about exploring the wild landscape, fishing, hunting, and carrying out her daily chores. But when a marine crew appears intent on extracting rare minerals, devastating the ocean depths in the process in the name of ecological transition, the balance of her little corner of paradise is under threat.

Alone and isolated, Eva will have to do whatever it takes to prevent this environmental disaster and preserve her peaceful hideaway.

Sumptuous artwork and colors from a writer who is showing increasing artistic talent with each new book.
















JIM François schuiten

A beautiful tribute to the bond between humans and animals.

In drawing Jim, his recently deceased dog, François Schuiten found within the art of comic books the means to fill the void inside and to honor the pet that meant so much to him. Following the death of his quiet yet faithful friend, the artist paid tribute to him by creating a new illustration each day to feel his presence a little longer, while coming to accept the fact that he was gone.

The book highlights the powerful, invisible bonds that are forged between people and their pets, bringing comfort to those who are dreading—or have already experienced—the inevitable end to an extraordinary relationship.



François Schuiten is a famous comic book author. He made his first two books in collaboration with Claude Renard: Aux medians de Cymbiola in 1980 and Le Rail in 1981. Since then, he has worked with Benoît Peeters on the series Les Cités obscures, which has received numerous prizes.

He also designed the Train World Museum in Brussels, as well as subway stations and exposition pavilions.

A poignant and terrible confrontation between two men and two ideals, *Mourning Snow* sets a tragedy of honor in the splendid and inhuman setting of the high mountains.

Two brothers, Isaïe and Marcellin, have always lived on their family farm in the heart of the mountains. Scarred by a serious mountaineering accident that left him with severe injuries, Isaïe now lives to tend his flock. While Marcellin dreams of leaving his monotonous life behind and moving to the city to open his own store. One day, a plane crashes into the top of the mountain. After hearing a rumor that it was carrying gold, Marcellin is prepared to do whatever it takes to retrieve it and proposes a dangerous expedition, even if it means jeopardizing his relationship with his brother.

Inspired by the real story of the Air India Flight crash on Mont Blanc in 1950.



Dominique Monféry is a director, animator, and storyboard artist, and started his career at Disney in the 90s. His work for them included the short film *Destino* which was nominated for an Oscar in 2005. His first publication for Rue de Sèvres, *Mortel imprévu* (2022), was a huge success, winning a Talents Cultura award.

Henri Troyat was born in Moscow in 1911 and died in

Paris in 2007. He was awarded numerous literary awards, including the prestigious Prix Goncourt. La neige en deuil, inspired by the Air India's Flight crash, was published in 1952, and was adapted on screen in 1956, under the title The Mountain, starring Robert Wagner and Spencer Tracy.

April 1940. In a state of shock following the suicide of an elderly man before her very eyes, Louise finds herself running naked through the streets of Paris.

While attempting to make sense of the bizarre circumstances in which she has become embroiled, she gets drawn into her own mother's past and discovers that she has a secret half-brother.

She then crosses paths with Raoul, a soldier who has been imprisoned for desertion; Fernand, a prison guard; and Désiré, a mysterious and complex individual.



After studies in psychology, Pierre Lemaitre turned to professional education for adults, giving teaching seminars on literature to librarians. He then devoted himself to writing novels and screenplays, essentially detective stories. In 2013, Au revoir là-haut, a picaresque novel that marks a major change in his work, won the Goncourt Prize.

Christian De Metter started his career by studying advertising design before working as an illustrator and graphic designer for rock magazines. In 1999, he published his first comic, and six years later he received the Public Award at the Angoulême Comics Festival.













A direct sequel to the Mutafukaz movie and comics, but which can still be read independently from the main series and spin-offs.





Louise Joor's first story, *Kanopé*, was published by Editions Delcourt in 2012. She followed this up in 2016 with *Neska du clan du Lierre*, and since 2022 she has been collaborating on the acclaimed *Les Légendaires* saga. She already worked with Augustin Lebon on *Résilience* (Casterman) in 2012.

Augustin Lebon studied at the Institut Saint-Luc arts school in Brussels, which is where he met Lylian, with whom he would publish *Le Révérand* (Emmanuel Proust Éditions) in 2012. He later collaborated with Louise Joor on *Résilience* and in 2023 he turned his attention to children's books with *Le Grand Migrateur*, published by Rue de Sèvres.

But when one of the last remaining sleeping giants awakens to the surprise of all, the hunt for the beast begins afresh. Odette, a mysterious and eccentric old woman who is convinced that the scourge of the black goo is linked to the disappearance of the giants, sets out to find and protect it from mankind at all costs.


She is determined to accompany the enormous creature on its journey to the farthest reaches of the kingdom in the hope of discovering a cure for her decaying world.

1968 in a small town in New York State. An abusive father and a beaten-down mother. Two older brothers—one violent, the other traumatized by the Vietnam War. Not enough money at home. Odd jobs to stay afloat. Too many fights at school. A library open on Saturdays in which to escape. A collection of birds scattered to the four winds. Unrealized talent. And a fierce desire to get to grips with life. Against this grim backdrop, though one not entirely without hope, Doug strives to be more than the "skinny thug" everyone takes him to be. With the help of an unexpected ally, Lil, he finds the strength to face the transition from adolescence into adulthood and the desire to dream of a brighter future.

Nicolas Pitz, an increasingly talented artist, has created a brilliant adaptation of Gary D. Schmidt's novel.



Nicolas Pitz made his comic book debut as a scriptwriter and illustrator with the trilogy *Luluabourg*, inspired by the life of his grandfather. In 2018, he did his first comic adaptation with Rue de Sèvres: the novel *La Bobine d'Alfred* by Malika Ferdjoukh.

Gary D. Schmidt is an English teacher in Michigan and is the father of six children. He has written dozens of children's books, winning numerous awards in the US.
